गुडगाँव बचाएगा थैलेसीमिया से पीड़ित मरीजों को



इनवाईरो द्वारा एक महीने का रक्तदान शिविर कार्यक्रम का आयोजन

गुडगाँव: वाटिका ग्रुप की एकीकृत सुविधा प्रबंधन कंपनी, इनवाईरो द्वारा एक महीने का रक्तदान शिविर कार्यक्रम का आयोजन किया गया है। यह रक्तदान कैंप 21 जून को शुरू किया गया है जो कि 25 जुलाई तक चलेगा। इस कार्यक्रम के अंतर्गत अभी वाटिका के दो प्रोजेक्ट - वाटिका ट्रेंगल और वाटिका फर्स्ट इंडिया प्लेस पर कैंप लगाए गए हैं जिससे 104 यूनिट रक्त इकट्ठा हो चुका है। इसके आलावा यह रक्तदान शिविर, वाटिका के विभिन्न प्रोजेक्ट्स – वाटिका सिटी पॉइंट, वाटिका प्रोफेशनल पॉइंट, वाटिका टावर, वाटिका एट्रियम, वाटिका बिज़नस पार्क, वाटिका माइंडस्केप और वाटिका सिटी पर लगाए जाएंगे। इस शिविर में वाटिका के कर्मचारीयों सिहत कोई भी आम जनता आकर स्वेछा से रक्तदान कर सकता है।

एकत्रित किए गए रक्त को राष्ट्रीय थैलेसीमिया सोसायटी को प्रदान किया जायेगा। जिसका पूरा का पूरा इस्तेमाल थैलेसीमिया रोगी के ईलाज के लिए खर्च किया जाएगा।

थैलेसीमिया एक अनुवांशिक रक्त रोग है जिसके कारण रोगी के शरीर में लाल रक्त कण और हीमोग्लोबिन की मात्रा सामान्य से कम हो जाती है फलतः रोगी को बार - बार रक्त चढ़ाना पड़ता है। भारत में हर वर्ष 7 से 10 हजार बच्चे थैलेसीमिया से पीड़ित पैदा होते है। थैलेसीमिया होने से रोगी को बार - बार रक्त चढाना पड़ता है और ऐसा ना करने पर रोगी जीवित नहीं रह पाता है। इनवाईरों के वाईस-प्रेसिडेंट अजय कुमार ने बताया कि "थैलेसीमिया दुनिया में सबसे आम आनुवंशिक विकार में से एक है, और हम मानते है की इन मरीजों को जीवन का उपहार मिलना चाहिए। इसलिए इनवाईरों ने इस रक्तदान शिविर का आयोजन किया है और जरुरतमंद लोगों के जीवन रक्षण के लिए काम करने पर गर्व है।"

रक्तदान शिविर में दान करने वाली मेघा ने कहा कि "आज सुबह सबसे पहले खून देना मुझे काफ़ी अच्छा लगा | जरुरत के समय किसी को यह अमूल्य उपहार देना, उनके लिए काफ़ी मददगार साबित होता है |"
